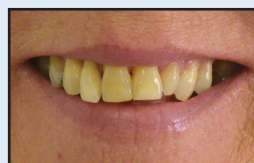
No Fear Tooth Extraction With Same Day Replacement

Smiling is natural. The idea of smiling with a missing tooth can be daunting. So when the treatment plan includes extractions and dental implants, patients are extremely apprehensive. A common concern "Will I leave with a replacement tooth?" Well, there is good news. We regularly treat cases in which teeth are extracted and restored with a fixed replacement the very same day.

Here's one such case:

Case in Brief: Patient had extremely severe gum disease and the teeth could not be retained. She was also looking for an improved smile.

The Solution: Over the course of two visits, all teeth were extracted then dental implants placed and restored with immediate fixed temporary replacements.
